Dear President Chan:

By means of this letter, our office confirms several actions taken by the WASC Senior College and University Commission (WSCUC) that were communicated to you and your leadership team by telephone but were not sufficiently documented in writing.

Following a site visit during the fall semester of 2012, and based on a positive team recommendation, the Commission acted at its February 2013 session to grant Initial Accreditation to International Technological University (ITU). The Commission was not aware that ITU had in fact graduated a cohort in December 2012, subsequent to the site visit. Our agency adopted a policy in 2007 that allowed it, under these circumstances, to set the effective date of Initial Accreditation back to cover these graduates. The conditions of the policy are that the visiting team needs to have been at the institution during the final term of the students' matriculation in order to verify the institution's ability to bring the students to their culminating learning.

Based on this policy, the Executive Committee of the Commission considered a request at its April 23, 2013, meeting to set the effective date for ITU's Initial Accreditation at December 1, 2012. This request was granted by unanimous vote of the Executive Committee.

The effective date was communicated at that time to the institution, was entered in the agency's database, and is reflected on the WSCUC website for ITU. By means of this letter, WSCUC is providing written verification of the above actions.

We wish you continued success as you serve your students.
